- \* [Gemstone Elixir](#) This is an absolute no-go with the gems in these reviews !! ([unless you do it this way](#))
- \*\* These gemstones can be cleaned quickly with water but are not suitable for [Elixir](#)
- Jewelry with metal furnitures cannot be used for making Gemstone Elixir or cleansed with water.
- All other Gemstones with a [Hardness](#) under 5 on the Mohs scale are in principle unsuitable for contact with water.
- Everything that applies to water also applies to alcohol, drinking water, elixir, oils, rainwater, liquids, salt water and sweat.

[Methodes](#) which the above applies

- Daily Self-care, take these gems NOT count in the bathroom and be careful in the kitchen.
- Wear as jewelry for babies growing children and sensory hypersensitives \*

We only work with pure natural gemstones, therefore the above overview is not entirely complete.

Imitation stones, can't be bought at my shop, but if they found a way into your house by mistake, just know this: imitations like all aqua aura, gold stone, Opalite, Turquenite (etc.) variants and chemically recolored stones, can better **not be touched by water** because these are often covered and/ or infused with highly toxic substances to imitate the natural colors of natural gemstones.

## Hardness
